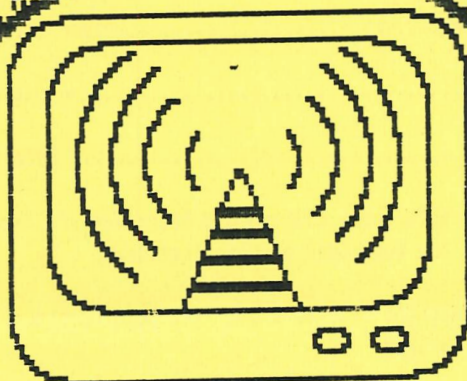

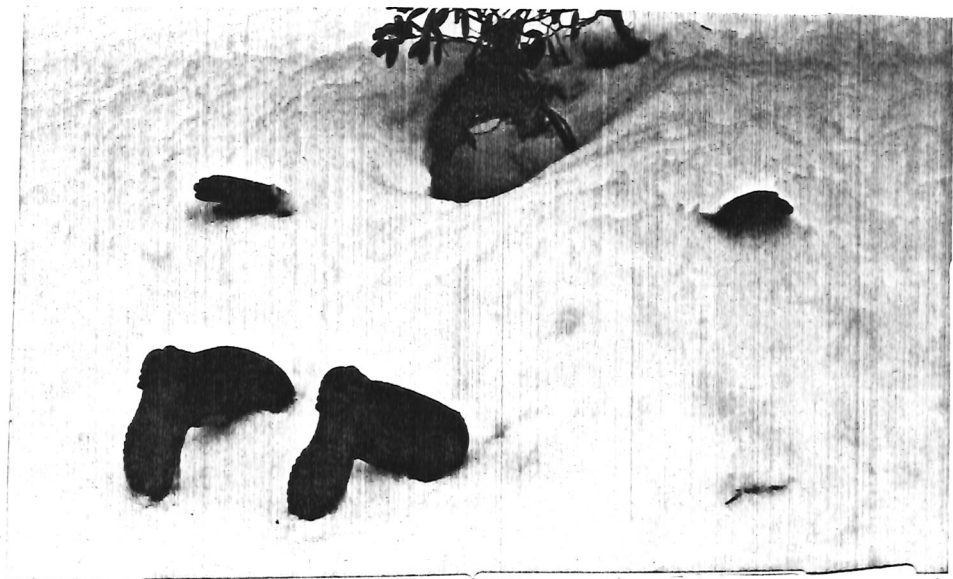
## EDITORS REPORT

The next edition of Gateway shall be compiled by Dave, VK3XMF while I am on holiday in the U.S. Send your articles in early and beat the rush.

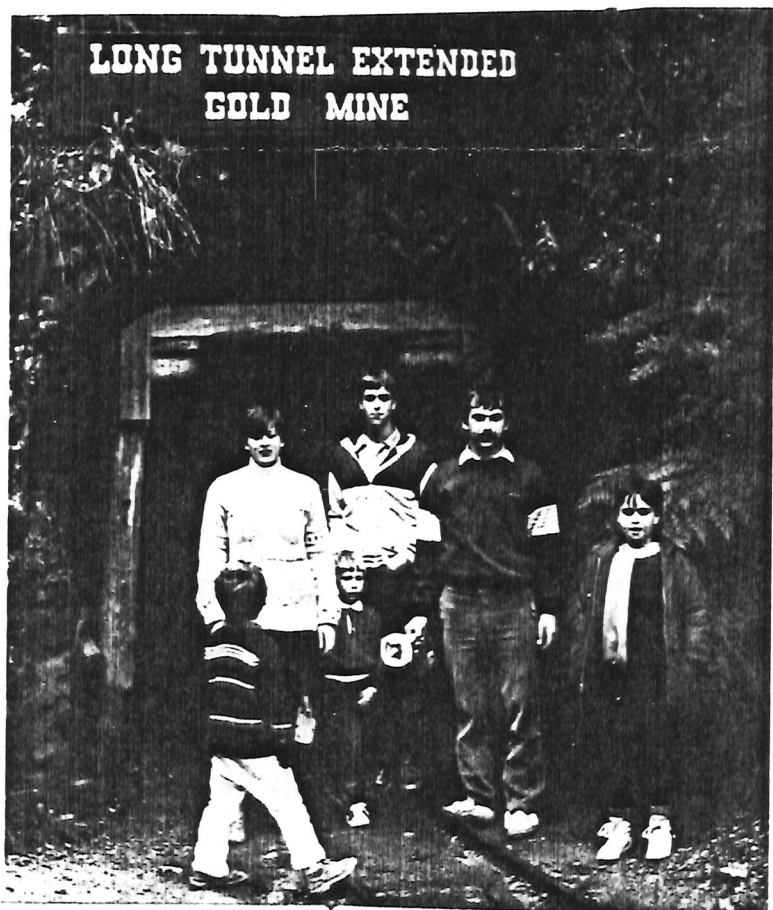
